

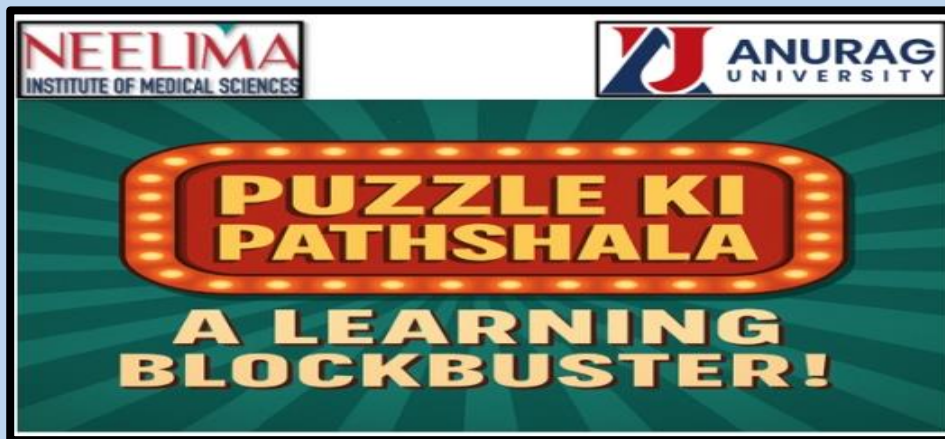

## Quiz Structure
